## 1. Matters Concerning Applicants

- The applicant's address and information regarding the location of the evacuation site shall be inspected or referred to the relevant administrative agency, in order to confirm the household to which the assistance fund is to be made.
- The applicant is aware that the fund may not be granted depending on the result of the confirmation of the contents of the application, and if the application arrives after the designated application period.
- The applicant is not currently participating or involved in organized crime, and will not participate or be involved in any organized crime in the future.
- If the fund is received through fraudulent means or false application, the applicant may be ordered to return it.

## 2. Matters concerning guarantors

The guarantor must not currently fall under or be involved in any of the following, or fall under or be involved in any of the following in the future;

- Organized Crime Group, as defined in Article 2, Item 2 on the Act on Prevention of Unjust Acts by Organized Crime Group Members (Act No.77, 1991) and Organized Crime Group Members as defined in Article 2, Item 6 of the same act.
- Cooperating or involved in the maintenance or operation of organized crime groups by supplying funds, favors, etc. to groups or members.
- Those who are affiliated with organized crime groups or organized crime group members.
